Mount Berry and Rome, Georgia

The fall meeting of the Georgia Ornithological Society was held on September 21 and 22 at Mount Berry and Rome with Dalton as a joint host. I was happy to be able to attend, meeting old friends and, as usual having a fine time. The Berry School, a remarkable institution for the people of that area, was thrown open to us and our gatherings were well attended. Dr. Harold Jones of the Faculty gave us a cordial welcome. The campus of 2500 acres of land is a bird sanctuary with a record of 165 species recorded at that time.
