

Meeting description taken verbatim from Earle Greene's A Lifetime with the Birds An Ornithological Logbook¹

April 19-20, 1941 Atlanta, Georgia

The Georgia Ornithological Society held its Ninth Semi-annual meeting at Emory University and Atlanta on April 19 and 20, the Atlanta Bird Club being the host. During this meeting I reported on the progress being made on the intended list of birds of the Okefenokee Swamp which Tony Carter and I were preparing. At the banquet Dr. R. C. Rhodes, of the Biology Department at Emory, acted as Toastmaster. Dr. Eugene P. Odom and Harold S. Peters gave excellent talks on their lines of work. On Sunday morning a field trip and breakfast was had at North Fulton Park, followed by dinner at Fernbank Forest.
