1992 FALL MEETING SUMMARY

Eighty GOS members lucked out on the weather in St. Marys, Georgia, October 9-11. They had 10" of rain earlier in the week, but the weekend was clear and beautiful. Friday evening Joe Kurz, Chief of the Game Management Division, Georgia DNR, stimulated a lively discussion of timber cutting practices on Sapelo Island, and Jim Ozier, wildlife biologist with DNR's Nongame Wildlife Program brought us up to date on that undertaking. Saturday, teams of birders fanned out to hotspots in the area to produce a Saturday evening countdown, conducted by Donny Screws, of 141 species, thanks to the able leadership of local birders like Bert Rhyne (Cumberland), Mike Chapman (Brunswick), Bob Loftin (Florida), and Gary Drury and Lydia Thompson (Jekyll).

Saturday evening's speaker, Cindy Mosling, brought live owls, a video, slides and her petite and charming self to tell about the monumental work of salvaging and rehabilitating birds that she and her small, privately funded organization undertakes.

Both first-timers and old-hands on Cumberland Island were fortunate to have Bert Rhyne, Museum Curator at the National Seashore, and ranger Brian Quigley as their "personal guides." Their knowledge of the history, geology, botany and biology - avian and otherwise - made for a memorable experience.

Ten adventurous souls had a memorable experience when they accepted an invitation to tour the Kings Bay U.S. Navy Submarine Base and go aboard the USS George Bancroft, a Polaris class nuclear submarine. An extra dividend for the group on the return trip through the base was a sighting from the tour bus of a White Pelican and a Roseate Spoonbill.

GOS OCCASIONAL PUBLICATIONS

On several occasions, we have requested through the newsletter that we needed copies of the first three Occasional Publications of the Society for the archives. Thanks to the generosity of Dr. Herbert W. Kale, we now have copies of number 2 and number 3. Dr. Kale recently donated his personal copies of these books to the Society. In his note, Dr. Kale mentions that the copy of *Birds of Georgia*, *A Preliminary Check-List and Bibliography*, Occasional Publication Number 2 was given to him by Dr. Eugene Odum at the time that Dr. Kale was in graduate school at the University of Georgia in the 1950's. The copy bears Dr. Odum's signature.

In addition, Dr. Kale recently found a copy of Occasional Publication #1, *The Birds of Athens, Clarke County, 1938,* in a group of items collected by the late E. O. Mellinger. They were given to Florida Ornithological Society by Marie Mellinger. Dr. Kale has in turn sent the book to us so that GOS would have a complete set of our occasional publications.

NEW GOS P.O. BOX

A badly needed new Post Office has been opened in Cartersville. As a part of the move, the Post Office Box number for the Society has been changed to Post Office Box 1684, Cartersville, GA, 30120. Please make a note of this address change. this is the address used for all dues payments, book orders and communication with the Business Manager. If you should have some membership blanks or other GOS materials, it would be helpful if you would take a minute to change the box number on those items before you give them to others.

NEW BIRDSEED MIX

New GOS member, Ron Miller developed, with the input of Georgia Department of Natural Resources, quality, low priced bird seed mixes which are being marketed by a prominent grocery chain including 122 locations throughout the southeast. Jim Ozier, Wildlife Biologist, states that most mixes that are available at the lowest prices in grocery and department stores contain a high percentage of sorghum, wheat, and other filler seeds that add bulk to the mix, but are not highly palatable to songbirds. As a result, much of the seed mix is wasted as the birds pick through to find the few sunflower seeds, white proso, and other seeds that they prefer. Mr. Miller's mix containing 70% black oil sunflower seeds and kernels, 15% white proso, 10% cracked corn, and 5% canary, should result in very little waste. Pine Haven seed in 5 pound bags sells for \$2.29 a bag, a few cents less than plain sunflower seed.

BICYCLING AND BIRDING

My annual 400+ mile Bicycle Ride Across Georgia (BRAG) this past June began in northwest Georgia 6/14. Riding about 55-60 miles/day for a week, yielded 72 species. Numbers included 700 American Robins, 500+ Northern Mockingbirds, more than 475 each of Eastern Meadowlarks, and Carolina Wrens, followed by 400+ each of Chimney Swifts and Barn Swallows. I was not surprised by the 200+ Northern Bobwhites, House Sparrows, and Red-winged Blackbirds, but was surprised by 250+ Field Sparrows and 250+ Indigo Buntings and 150+ Song Sparrows. Other emberizids included 32 N. Parula Warblers, 52 Pine Warblers, 91 Common Yellowthroats, 64 Summer Tanagers, 100 Northern Cardinals, 200 Rufous-sided Towhees, 8 Grasshopper Sparrows, 30 Orchard Orioles, 30 House Finches, and 2 American Goldfinches. while there were 115 Downy Woodpeckers, I say only one! Chuck-wills-widows in Waleska and Whip-poor-wills in Elberton made the 6:00AM wake-up enjoyable. Fewest species: Great Blue Herron-1, American Coot-2, Sharp-shinned Hawk-1, Yellow-billed Cuckoo-4, Barred Owl-2, and House Wren-3.

HELP GIVE WILDLIFE A CHANCE

Over 95% of Georgia's wildlife is nongame; not legally hunted, trapped or fished. This includes more than 3,500 plant and 900 animal species. Currently more than 66 plant and 27 animal species are endangered and near extinction. This species depletion is mainly due to commercial, agricultural and residential housing development.

With only 8% of Georgia protected, this alarming trend must be slowed. If not, over two million acres of wildlife habitat will be lost by the end of the decade. The Nongame Endangered Wildlife Program is helping to ensure the future of Georgia's wildlife through land acquisition, wildlife habitat management and research. This program has funded statewide Wood Stork foraging areas and nesting surveys, Bald Eagle, Golden Eagle and Peregrine hacking projects, publications on the Ruby-throated Hummingbird and the Eastern Bluebird, as well as maintaining a Bluebird Trail and wading bird pond habitat areas.

You can help by contributing part of your tax refund or overpayment to The Nongame Endangered Wildlife Fund. Invest in wildlife by entering the amount you choose on line 26 of your state income tax form.

1993 PELAGIC TRIPS

Snapper Banks-February 7 (Weather Date Feb. 21) Edge of Gulf Stream-May 23, August 22 and November 14

We will explore the ocean waters east of Savannah, GA looking for pelagic birds. Expected species on the summer trips are Cory's Shearwaters, Greater Shearwaters, Sooty Shearwaters (May only), Audubon's Shearwaters, and Bridled Terns. We have a chance to see Wilson's Storm-Petrels, Pterodroma Petrels, Boobies, Tropic-birds and Sooty Terns. We had a Brown Noddy last August. On the winter trips, we can expect to see winter sea ducks, Northern Gannets, Phalaropes, Jaegers, and perhaps Black-legged Kittiwakes, Fulmars and Skuas.

Cost for the Snapper Banks trip is \$96.00; cost for the Gulf Stream trip is \$150.00. All trips leave from Wilmington Island, Savannah, GA. Directions, a list of accommodations, and full details will be sent with your reservation confirmation.

Trips not filled 30 days prior to departure (when deposit is due to the boat captain) will be canceled. Please reserve early! A RESERVATION COMMITS THE PARTICIPANT TO THE WEATHER DATE IF NECESSARY.
