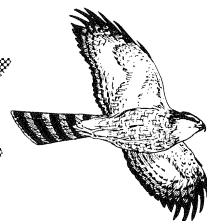

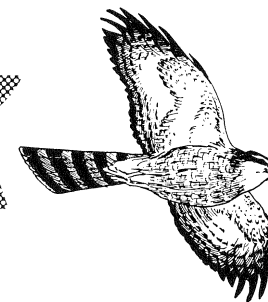

Sara Morris enthralled us with her beautiful slides of birds captured in nets during her research activities, and her enthusiasm for birds and birding was contagious. She is also a fine teacher and conducted a very instructive workshop on bird identification on Saturday afternoon.

Bruce Hallett, our Saturday speaker, whetted our appetites for birding in the Dry Tortugas with his excellent slides of the area and his lively and interesting narration. At the conclusion of a short business meeting following the presentation, officers for the ensuing two years were elected as follows: Helen Ogren, President; Jack Cooper, First Vice President; Eugenia Thompson, Second Vice President; Didi Manns, Secretary; and Doug Phillips, Treasurer.

As a final note to a very enjoyable evening, Dick Parks presented the Earl Greene Award for outstanding service in Ornithology to outgoing president Dr. Branch Howe for his accomplishments in the field while serving as GOS president.

ENVIRONMENTAL FUND FOR GEORGIA and GEORGIA ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL

The Georgia Ornithological Society belongs to both the Environmental Fund for Georgia and the Georgia Environmental Council. Do you understand the difference? The Environmental Fund for Georgia has one purpose only: fundraising for the environment through payroll deductions. It is in its first year, and it is patterned after similar organizations in more than one-half the states in the U.S.

The EFG is incorporated and has its 501-(c)-3 status with the IRS. So far, fourteen organizations belong, including GOS; the others are The Nature Conservancy of Georgia, the Museum of Arts and Sciences (Macon), the Sierra Club Foundation, The Southern Environmental Law Center, the Trust for Public Land, The Outdoor Activity Center, the Sautee-Nacoochee Community Association, The Atlanta Audubon Society, the Campaign for a Prosperous Georgia, the Southface Energy Institute, the Elachee Nature Science Center, the Legal Environmental Assistance Foundation, and Environmental Community Action (ECO-Action).

EFG made application to selected federal districts in Georgia, with the result that the designation, "ENVIRONMENTAL FUND FOR GEORGIA" was on the pledge cards of all federal workers in the greater municipal areas of Atlanta, Savannah, Macon, and Columbus. In addition, several private businesses and law firms included the EFG on pledge cards for the consideration of their employees.

This first year, the return from these pledges will undoubtedly be modest, but whatever comes in will be equally divided among the member organizations. However, as more employers and employees are persuaded to take part in this program, the share will be larger for all of us, and the environment will be that much further benefitted. Our GOS share will be used, among other things, for scholarships to further ornithological study.

Those of you who live within a reasonable distance from Atlanta received an invitation to the first social gathering held by the Environmental Fund for Georgia. We hope many of you were there to meet Alice Rolls, CEO, and her Board of Directors representing the participating groups. If you have questions, please call me, or call Alice at (404) 873-3173.

The Georgia Environmental Council, on the other hand, focuses its activity on the General Assembly. The organization pays an observer to attend committee meetings pertaining to the environment, study relevant bills, and send a *Legislative Monitor* each week to designated individuals in the participating organizations and to Subscribers. (You, too, can be a Subscriber and for a modest fee receive these reports personally each week of the General Assembly - call me at my number below.) A summary of environmental legislation appears in the *GOShawk* each spring.

The GEC has several open meetings each year, including an Awards Picnic in June, a meeting with the Department of Natural Resources in the fall, and a fundraiser in early January to which Georgia legislators are invited. We should try to keep you informed of these events, and we promise to do so.

ORNITHOLOGICAL NEWSLETTER RECAP

A new national biological survey is to be created within the Department of Interior, consolidating the biological research and inventory activities of the Fish and Wildlife Service, the National Park Service, and the Bureau of Land Management, as well as smaller contributions from five other interior bureaus. Organizationally the NBS is to report to the Assistant Secretary for Fish and Wildlife and Parks. The Department of Interior is requesting comments about the proposal from the scientific community. To receive materials describing the NBS, write to The National Biological Survey Proposal, Department of the Interior, 1849 C. St., NW, Washington, DC 20240.

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the purchase of 2,333 acres for addition to three national wildlife refuges in July 1993. The additions include 796 acres at Bombay Hook NWR, DE; 36 acres at Back Bay NWR, VA; and 1,501 acres at the Roanoke River NWR, NC. The commission also approved \$5,329,913 in grants for 14 wetland conservation projects in Canada and Mexico. The grants, provided under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act, are to be matched by \$8,791,855 in funds and services contributed by public and private partners.

Data are needed for the *Birds of North America* species account. Swainson's Warbler data are needed including migration, winter range, measurements, food and physiology - Southern Forest Experiment Station; Nacogdoches, TX. Also needed is Wilson's Plover information. Any unpublished information or obscure publications would be appreciated - LSU-A Division of Sciences, Alexandria, LA. Data on migration, banding returns, and population status on the Grasshopper Sparrow, especially information from Central America and the Caribbean would be greatly appreciated; Peter Vickery, P.O. Box 127, Richmond, ME 04357.

The Dept. of Biology at Grand Valley State University, Allendale, MI is attempting to augment its teaching collection of bird study skins. Donations of study skins in good to excellent condition will be gratefully accepted.

to test the hypothesis that the sex of birds of six species currently considered sexually monomorphic is correlated with wing chord. Wing chord of known sex are needed on Blue Jay, Chipping Sparrow, Song Sparrow, Swamp sparrow, Northern Waterthrush, Northern Mockingbird, Wood Thrush and Veery.

Field assistants are needed for Red-cockaded Woodpecker project at Carolina Sandhills National Wildlife Refuge. Two field assistants are needed for shorebird population research on the South Carolina coast. duties will include catching and banding birds, observing color-marked birds, and nest-searching. Contact South Carolina Cooperative Fish and Wildlife Research Unit; Clemson, SC.

Field Research Assistants are needed for bird community study in continuous old growth, fragmented old growth, and clearcut units of Western Red Cedar/Western Hemlock in northern Idaho during May-July, 1994. Work is likely to extend into Aug. and possibly Sept. Contact Forestry Sciences Lab; Missoula, MT.

Biologists needed to survey and monitor birds in Arizona. Several seasonal/temporary positions are available ranging from \$17,755 to \$21,481 per year. Most positions begin in late winter/spring of 1994. Contact Nongame Branch, Arizona Game and Fish Dept.; Phoenix, AZ.

Field assistantships available with Manomet Bird Observatory beginning April, 1994 at heron colonies along the US northeast coast, including Delaware Bay, New York Harbor, Cape Cod and Boston Harbor. The *BWD Skimmer*, a new publication produced by *Bird Watcher's Digest* is a bimonthly newsletter designed to "skim" items of interest to bird watchers in general from the ornithological press, from journals, from bird club newsletters and from the general media. A Field guide to the Birds of Britain and Europe 5th edition" by R. T. Peterson, et.al, is now available. All species accounts have been rewritten, and the range maps updated.

The Colorado Bird Observatory in Brighton, CO, seeks past issues of the ornithological journals *Auk*, *Audubon Field Notes* and *American Birds*, *Birding*, *Bird Banding and Journal of Field Ornithology*, *Condor*, *Living Bird*, and *Western Birds* to fill gaps in our reference library.

Readers, please notice that we have begun to publish in the *GOShawk* brief excerpts from the *Ornithological Newsletter* published bimonthly by OSNA (Ornithological Societies of North America) from the consolidated office in Ithaca, NY. OSNA represents the four major ornithological societies of North America - *American Ornithologists' Union*, *Association of Field Ornithologists*, *Cooper Ornithological Society*, and *Wilson Ornithological Society*.

This newsletter provides brief notes on a great number of important items about ornithological projects, research, new positions, and publications. We can select only a few for inclusion in the *GOShawk*, choosing items of national importance to all birders, or those related to birds and environmental management in the southeastern states. Since we can, furthermore, provide only the highlights of selected items, some readers may want more details than we include in the *GOShawk*. The newsletter comes to all members of the national organizations listed above, and there are a number of these in Georgia who could share newsletter details if asked by GOS members. We will try to list some of these in a future *GOShawk*; for now, you may want to contact any of the following for details: *GOShawk* editor, Frank McCamey, Dick Parks.

BEN B. COFFEE, JR. 1904 - 1993

Among the "Great Ones" of ornithology, we would surely count Ben Coffee, a Life Member of the GOS since 1985. Ben died in Memphis, Tennessee, August 22nd, at the age of 89, leaving a lifetime of contributions to amateur ornithology in the southern states. We remember with pleasure the program he and Mrs. Coffey presented at the GOS spring meeting in 1984, in Atlanta.

Ben is survived by Lula Coffey, his wife of 63 years, a marriage referred to as "a lifelong birding expedition" by *The Migrant*, journal of the Tennessee Ornithological Society.

Ben was an active field birder throughout his life, making bird counts winter and spring to gather information on migratory patterns in the Mississippi Valley and breeding ranges of the Whip-poor-will and related species. He banded thousands of Chimney Swifts and herons of several kinds. These birds were recovered from northern Canada to the Caribbean and the mountains of Peru to provide new knowledge of their distribution.

When he retired from a career as a fire prevention engineer, Ben began anew in sound recordings of bird vocalizations. He and Lula traveled to South America and India to record previously unknown songs of tropical birds, discovering new species in new areas. Tapes of these efforts now form the Coffey Neotropical Collection in the bioacoustics laboratory at Florida State University, and several collections have been released on commercial audio tapes. He was honored for his work by election to Fellow of the American Ornithologists' Union, one of very few amateurs to ever achieve this recognition.

Ben grew up in Nashville with a strong interest in the Boy Scouts. He was an Eagle, and later a Scoutmaster in Memphis. He always included Boy Scouts in his bird research and guided many toward a lifetime of natural history achievements. For this, he was awarded the Silver Beaver, scouting's highest honor for an adult.

Describing Ben's association with the TOS, Susan McWhirter, president of the Memphis chapter wrote, "...he wasn't 'old' at 89, a man with a gift of memory and recall that was truly astounding; an 'amateur' ornithologist in name only. He set standards of accuracy and exactness in the records of bird sightings that made us all more careful observers...his love of birds encouraged us, and his devotion to Lula, his bride of 63 years, touched our hearts."

Having shared birding with him so many years in so many places, I'll always think fondly of him and the importance of the "amateur" in birding for so many of us. Franklin McCamey
